Application Procedure

1. Upon receipt of the application materials, complete all that is requested so that the application may be considered by the Admissions Board at Saint John's Seminary. All items should be mailed to:

2. **Application Procedure**

- Completion of a written essay specific to the degree program
- Submission of all Undergraduate and Graduate Academic Transcripts, sent to Saint John's Seminary directly from the institution.
- Submission of **Three** recommendations: **One** from a priest who can assess your abilities,
- **Two** additional recommendations from other individuals who can assess your abilities. An assessment of academic ability is highly recommended.
- **For Applicants who are married, please include a copy of your Sacramental Marriage Certificate.**
- Fully completed written Application with accompanying Application Fee of \$75.00

2. Upon receipt of all of the above-mentioned materials, the Director of the Master of Arts in Ministry Program/Master of Theological Studies will contact you to arrange for the following Admission interviews:

- Interviews with the Director and Committee
- Psychological Profile (MAM applicants only)

3. Tuition for the Academic Year is:

\$675 per academic credit; \$2025 per three credit course
MAM Formation Fee: \$800 per semester for four semesters
MTS Formation/Colloquium Fee: \$800 per semester for four semesters
Field Education: \$1,000 per semester for four semesters

4. Upon acceptance to the MAM or MTS degree program by the Admissions Board of Saint John's Seminary, the applicant must confirm their acceptance in writing. For MAM applicants, a \$250 non-refundable enrollment fee should be included.

5. Financial aid and scholarships are available to qualified applicants.
